- II. Head of School Updates- Mr. Neal
  - A. Capital Planning Project: Mr. Neal reminded the team that the process of planning takes time, but following the protocols is important to ensure our families receive the school they deserve. Capital planning for Madison Park will be successful, but it can take extra time, and it promises the community a new school.
  - B. Programs MP is pursuing, while navigating budget cuts, Madison Park is working to expand some programs that will attract students and families in the years to come.
